


1. Safety of Participants




Monitor Soil & Air Temperatures-



- PICK & CHOOSE YOUR BATTLES CAREFULLY




- Attitude-"Whatever it takes, Whenever it takes it!"

- Set up bench marks showing progress





Know Your Audience




- What is important to the Folks you interact with on a daily basis?








Thing do not always go the way you Plan
