



Georgia State University Turf Intern

Job Description- Georgia State University in downtown Atlanta, GA is looking for a Summer Turf Intern to help maintain their Intercollegiate Athletic Fields. The intern will both learn and help in maintaining Hybrid Bermuda grass fields for baseball, softball, soccer, and a 60 yard football practice field. They will also assist with a synthetic football practice field. The intern will work with the GSU Grounds Staff in maintaining the fields and surrounding areas during the summer months. Jobs and projects will consist of mowing, fertilizing, verticutting, aerifying, painting, edging, mound and plate repair, irrigation repair, and more. Other work will include preparation for late spring baseball and softball games as well as fall football and soccer practices. This is a great experience to see first hand how warm season fields are maintained during the peak growing months.

Requirements- Candidates must have a strong work ethic and a desire to learn. Prior turf experience is not required, as both people with and without prior experience will in different ways gain important knowledge and experience.

Compensation- Based on experience. Affordable housing accommodation available.

Start/End- This position is designed for students who are still in school and want to gain great hands-on experience during summer break months (May to late August). Exact dates are flexible for each situation.
