The STMA Field of the Year Award program began in 1992, and has presented more than 100 awards to deserving sports field managers. In 2002, the Complex of the Year was added to recognize those facilities that have a minimum of four fields and host a minimum of three different sports.

A panel of judges from the STMA Awards Committee independently scores each entry based on the playability and appearance of the playing surfaces, innovative solutions employed, effective use of budget, and the development and implementation of a comprehensive, sound agronomic program.
