Through our Field of the Year Program we are able to greatly further one main element of our mission: To gain acknowledgement for the professionalism of our members.

This year, based on the results of the judging, the following awards may be presented at the STMA Annual Awards Banquet, Friday, Jan. 14, 2011, in Austin, Texas:

- STMA Baseball Field of the Year in the Schools and Parks, College and University, and Professional Categories
- STMA Softball Field of the Year in the Schools and Parks, College and University Categories
- STMA Football Field of the Year in the Schools and Parks, College and University, and Professional Categories
- STMA Soccer Field of the Year in the Schools and Parks, College and University, and Professional Categories
- STMA Sporting Grounds of the Year in the Schools and Parks, College and University, and Professional Categories

In addition to being featured in SportsTurf Magazine winning fields will also receive:

- A plaque recognizing the field and the Sports Turf Manager
- Registration to the STMA Conference
- Up to \$500 towards travel/lodging at the STMA Conference
- STMA signature apparel for the winning sports turf manager and their crew

All entry materials must be submitted according to the procedures outlined in this document. The awards committee, consisting of highly-regarded STMA professionals, will independently judge the entries. Winners will be notified in November 2010.

STMA Sporting Grounds of the Year

In order to better serve the STMA membership and provide the most opportunities for members to apply, the STMA Awards Committee eliminated the Complex of the Year category and replaced it with the new STMA Sporting Grounds of the Year category.

In establishing the STMA Sporting Grounds of the Year, the Awards Committee has targeted athletic fields which host "unique" sports outside of STMA's big four sports (football, baseball, softball, soccer) such as field hockey, lacrosse, rugby, cricket, tennis, and horse tracks. For a field to apply under the new category, it must host the "unique" sport for a majority of the play on a natural grass playing surface.

The new STMA Sporting Grounds of the Year applicants must follow the same guidelines and rules as STMA Field of the Year applicants, and winners receive the same recognition. Please fill out the application completely before sending it in to STMA. Feel free to contact STMA if you have questions about the new category or the STMA Field of the Year program in general.

CRITERIA FOR CONSIDERATION

The following criteria must be met to submit for the STMA Field of the Year Awards Program:

- 1. For the purposes of this program, a "field" constitutes ONE natural grass playing surface
- 2. To be considered, a field must have had two full seasons of play (may be concurrent, i.e. football and soccer on the same field in the fall, etc.)
- 3. The Sports Turf Manager submitting entry must be a national member of STMA
- 4. All materials must be submitted in one application packet to be considered

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLICATION

- This form is designed to assess ONE FIELD, not a complex. Please answer the questions as such.
- Type or neatly print application
- All photo criteria must be met, including dates each photo was taken
- Captions on all photos are encouraged
- Feel free to use your own word processor and/or spreadsheet, but questions must be answered in the same order that they appear in the application.
- Answer all questions as fully as possible. Include extra sheets or diagrams if you wish.
- Certain questions are to be answered in narrative form. These questions MUST BE TYPED in a 12 pt. font and double spaced. Please limit your answer to Question 9 to no more than 500 words.
- You may package your entry in any manner you wish (notebook, folder, binder, etc.), but STMA must receive a physical copy of your application.

NEW FOR 2010

- The STMA PCI© is now required to submit for the STMA Field of the Year Awards
 - A total of four separate, completed PCI Worksheets must be submitted with this application
 - Three or four conducted in season of the individual field's primary sport (depending on whether an off season PCI was conducted, see next point)
 - One conducted in the off season of the individual field's primary sport (if applicable in the 2010 Application Cycle ONLY)
 - The STMA PCI© may be found on the Members Only side of the STMA website, www.STMA.org or you may contact STMA at 800.323.3875 to obtain a copy. Membership is required to obtain the PCI and to apply for the STMA Field of the Year Awards.

- 11. Please list all equipment used. Include borrowed, leased, and owned equipment. A separate spreadsheet, chart, or other document may be included or you may type your answer in the space provided.
- 12. Please provide an organizational chart/diagram of all full-time, part-time, and seasonal staff dedicated to the field. A separate spreadsheet, chart, or other document may be included or you may type your answer in the space provided.
- 13. A total of four, separate, completed PCI Worksheets must be submitted
 - a. Three or four conducted in season of the individual field's primary sport (depending on whether an off season PCI was conducted, see next point)
 - b. One conducted in the off season of the individual field's primary sport (if applicable in the 2010 Application Cycle ONLY)

14. Please provide <u>no more than 30</u> quality, un-retouched photographs or digital images (see Attachment A) for the committee to review.

Applicants submitting more than 30 photos may be heavily penalized or disqualified at the discretion of the STMA Awards Committee.

THE PHOTOGRAPHS MUST INCLUDE PHOTOS FROM ALL SEASONS OF THE YEAR AND MUST BE DATED.

Suggestions from the Awards Committee:

The committee encourages creative photos, photos that show the versatility of the field, display unique characteristics of the field, and photos that show the unique talents of the crew. Focus on issues specific to your field which tell the story; issues such as drainage, traffic, weather, etc. Provide before and after shots. Do not simply provide 'beauty shots' of your field, as they do not reflect the true struggles and triumphs of you and your crew.

REQUIRED FOR ALL FIELD ENTRIES:

Pictures of the sidelines and other wear areas

Pictures of the center of the fields (between the hash marks, center field, etc.)

Pictures of the field from behind the goalmouth, goalposts, or home plate

Pictures of the field in use

Pictures of field in all seasons

Pictures of field renovation or unique issues (if applicable)

REQUIRED FOR BASEBALL AND SOFTBALL ONLY

Pictures of the dugouts and bullpens

ATTACHMENT A PHOTOGRAPHY CRITERIA

FOR JUDGING PURPOSES:

Photos:

- Preferred photo size: 4 x 6 inches or larger, color, high quality
- Please send no photo larger than 8 x 10 inches for judging consideration.
- All photos must include the date when the photo was taken.
- Please do not send loose photographs.

Digital Images:

Please submit high quality, digital photos (.jpg, .tif) (300 dpi or higher) on a CD. Please note that digital photos not meeting the above criteria will not be suitable for publication should your entry be named Field of the Year, so please make sure your digital images do fit the specs listed for <u>SportsTurf</u> below.

- As you photograph your field, take some vertical shots for potential magazine cover consideration.
- Send two CDs and/or two sets of color printouts in sleeves
- Please send no printout larger than 8 x 10 inches for judging consideration.

If selected as a Field of the Year Winner, STMA and/or *SportsTurf* Magazine will contact you for an interview and photo(s) of you, your crew, your field, and your facility.

Please note: If photos are printed from a digital image, the resolution of that original digital image must be no smaller than 300 dpi. Photos printed from images pulled off a website, at a resolution of 72 dpi, will not produce a quality print, and will most likely be rejected for magazine/association use. They cannot correct the quality of a pixilated photo once it has been printed.
