

Previously holding the position of Assistant Professor & Extension Turfgrass Specialist at Texas A&M University, coordinating turfgrass programs to ensure that turfgrass stakeholders in Texas implement BMPs of turfgrass. Focus areas include turfgrass physiology, weed control, species/



variety development and selection, and water use. NCSU research responsibilities included planting, plot management, data collection, data analysis, and report preparation for turfgrass breeding and selection trials as well as NC regional trials and NTEP trials.
